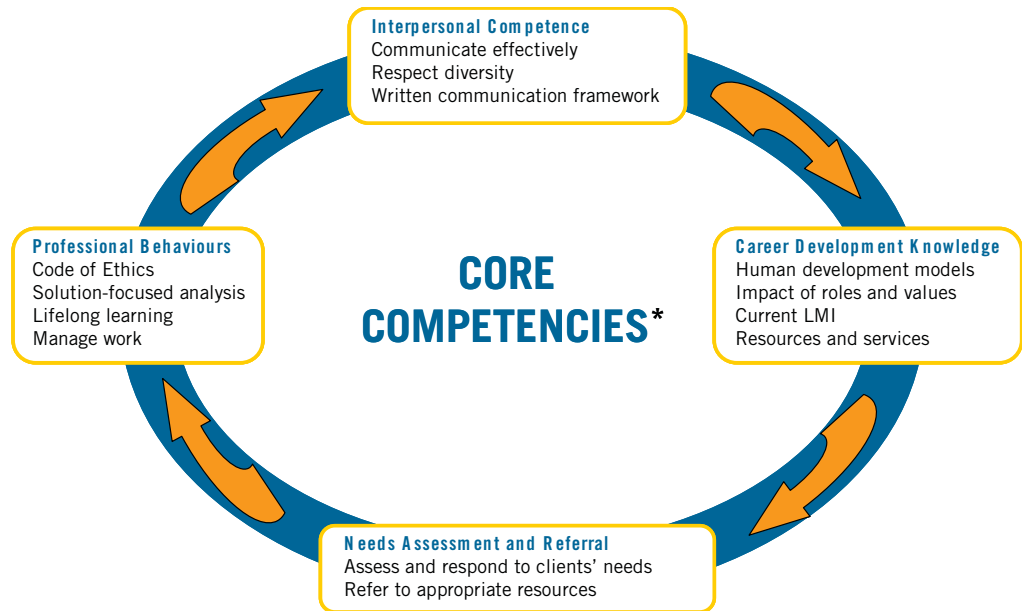
The field of career development is evolving and expanding today as never before. The demands of a rapidly changing economy make it imperative for practitioners to keep pace with new models for the practice of career development.

Addresses Core Competencies

The 110-hour program will address the core competencies for career practitioners as set out in the Canadian Standards and Guidelines. The modules will include:

- Introduction to Employment Services (online)
- Communication (3 days)
- Work Search Skills (4 days)
- Labour Market Information (LMI) (online)
- Assessing Client Employability Needs and Case Management (3.5 days)

Project

Each participant will be required to select a topic to explore in detail. These projects can be research or practice-based but emphasis will be on application.

Electives

Two electives are required and may be selected from a variety of sources including, but not limited to, those offered by the College of Continuing Education.

Adult Learning Model

Building on the principles of adult learning and teaching the Career Practitioner Certificate (CPC) program will combine theory and practice through highly interactive, dynamic experience-based classes and online forums. Participants will find that they learn as much from each other as from the highly skilled instructors.

Format

The CPC program will be offered in blended delivery both online and in class. Modules will be 2-4 days in length over one-weekend per month.
